

## LOCATION OF MDH FALL CAMP

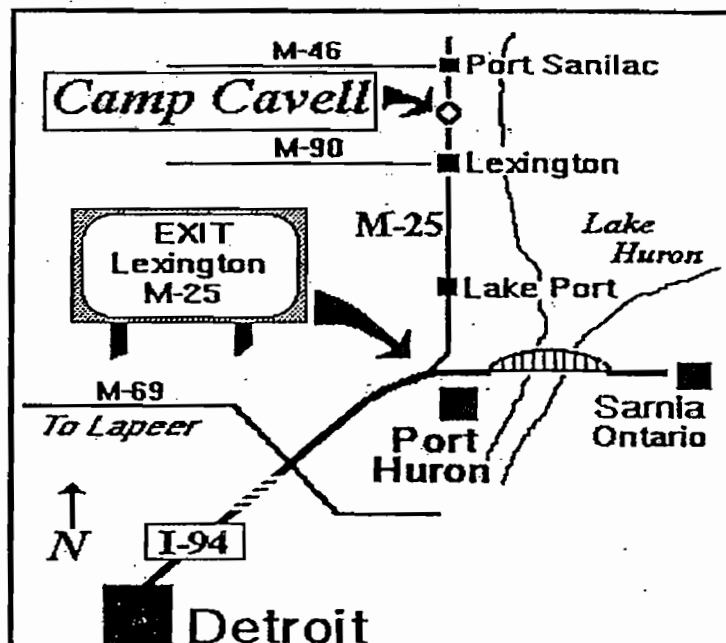
Camp Cavell is on the east coast of lower Michigan along the beautiful shores of Lake Huron. All camp facilities are nestled in the woods, on the east side of roadway M-25 between the towns of Lexington and Port Sanilac, north of Port Huron and the Blue Water Bridge.

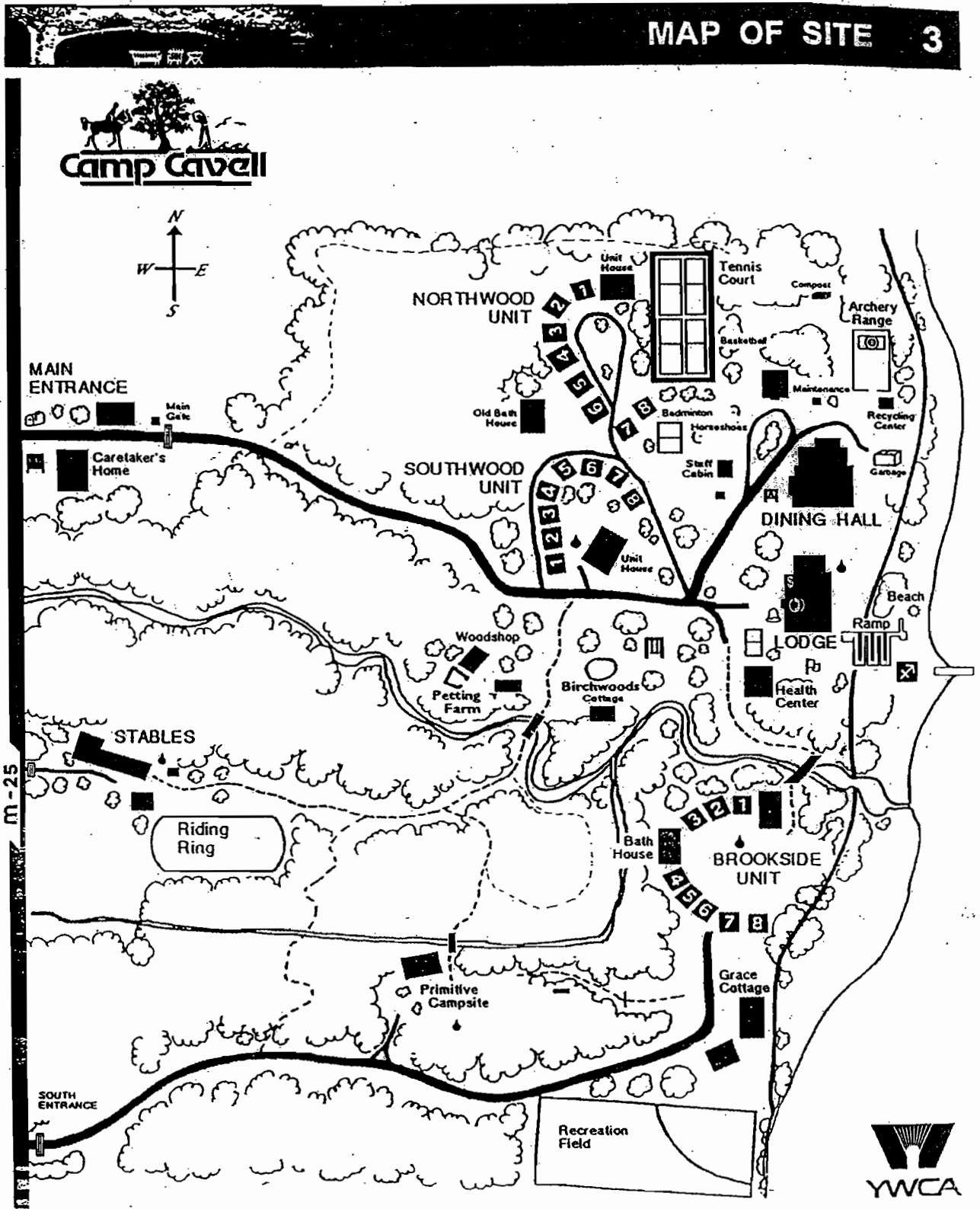
## DIRECTIONS

Take I-94 or I-69 east toward Port Huron. As you near Port Huron, take the Lexington exit and turn north (left) onto M-25. Travel north 45 minutes (29 - 1/2 miles). The camp entrance is on the right, 4 - 1/2 miles after you pass through Lexington. Port Sanilac is another 6 - 1/2 miles to the north of the Camp entrance. Drive the windy road in through the trees and when you enter the clearing on the Lake, you'll be facing the Main Lodge / Dance Hall for registration. Registration is upstairs in the Main Lodge.

## PARKING

Permanent parking is in a field across the stream south of the Dance Hall and south of the Brookside Unit House (Singing Cabin). To get to the field in your vehicle, you will have to go back out on the windy road, turn left on M-25 and drive a very short distance to an entrance on your left. Turn left and follow the road to the parking area. The path back to the Hall will be marked with reflective arrows. Remember to take your flashlight along if you park after dark.





Notes from Camp Cavell:

Smoking is not allowed in any building.

If you change your cabin location after signing up, please correct the listing. This is how we locate you in case of an emergency.

If you move beds, put them back before you leave.

Bring a **GOOD** flashlight. There are few outside lights and it is very dark at night.

Sweep the cabins and bag the trash before you leave.
